We are thrilled to invite you to mark the UN Women 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence (25th November - 10th December) with a screening of the film *Shayda* on the 30th of November 2023 with a special Q and A session afterwards with both the writer/director AND the subject of the film.

Shayda is a 2023 Australian drama film written, directed, and co-produced by Noora Niasari. Inspired by Niasari's childhood experiences, the story follows an Iranian immigrant woman in Australia who is raising her young daughter as the two live in a women's shelter, while also attempting to divorce her abusive husband.

This captivating film is the official submission in Australia for the 'Best International Feature Film' category of the 96th Academy Awards and had its world premiere at the Sundance Film Festival in January 2023 where it won the audience award and the grand jury prize. It also won the Cinefest OZ film prize in WA which is the largest cash film prize in Australia. You can watch the trailer <a href="here">here</a>.

## Ocean Grove Rotary Club Junior Community Awards.

The parents and teachers were also thanked for their assistance in completing the awards.

Geoff Chandler thanked all those people who made this program such a success and stated that once again the standard of work and areas of interest demonstrated by the students continues to show what a worthwhile exercise this project is.
