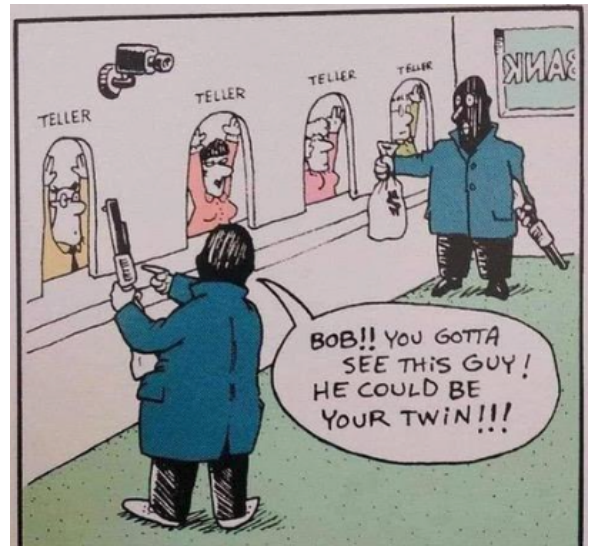
Rotarians and Dinner Guests
