As you know, our family has just returned from Cambodia, where we spent time with our students and alumni in Siem Reap, as well as more than 50 alumni now living and working in Phnom Penh. We feel deeply humbled to witness these once-rural "village kids" grow into the social leaders our society so urgently needs. Not only have they lifted themselves and their families out of poverty, but they continue to give back - contributing to their communities each week with purpose, compassion, and leadership.

While in Cambodia, we helped to set-up and open a new library at a rural school serving more than 1,000 students, distributed bicycles to rural students to support their access to education, and joined the Angkor Wat Half Marathon - raising \$7,000 to help build homes for impoverished rural families.
