Cadel Evans Bike Ride:

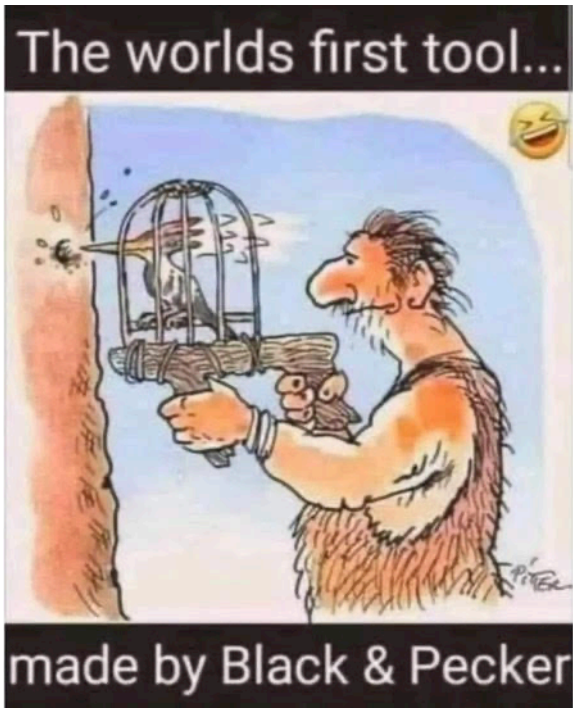
Over the Australia Day weekend, a number of our members will be acting as Marshalls during this event, earning the club much appreciated income. Thanks all !
