I wanted to give you guys some feedback.

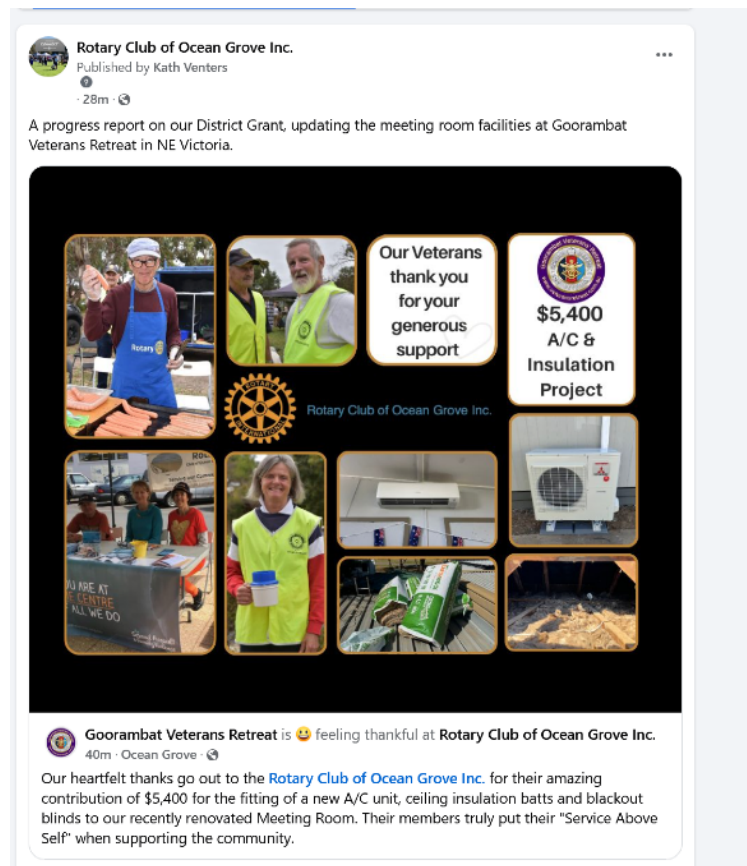
I had a really good day for sales, the site you had given me, I couldn't be happier - thank you, I would love to have that site all the time if possible.

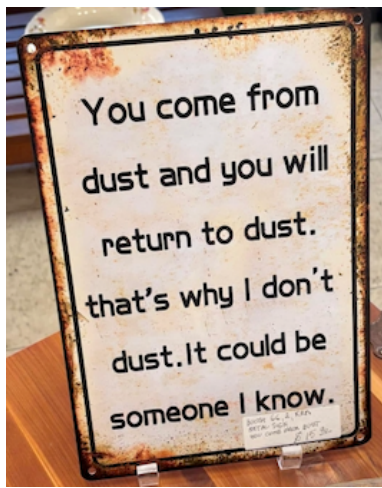
