RCOG Art Show - History and Process: Rod Bush



Aug 8, 2023

History: The Rotary Club of Ocean Grove Art Show began in 2011 organised initially by Coral Barker and then John Calnin. It was first held in the Queenscliff Town Hall but, with around 340 entries, this proved too small. In 2012, it was moved to the larger Point Lonsdale Primary School Hall which enabled it to become more efficient and better organised. The proceeds of the show are generally directed towards disability charities. The two major recipients have been Riding Develops Abilities and Disabled Surfers Association, Ocean Grove branch. A series of posters have been developed to advertise the show which are placed throughout the local district. Consistently high prize money of around \$10,000 has attracted high quality entries. In total, 334 paintings have been sold for \$181,760 giving a sales profit of \$45,438 which has been distributed to the community.

Process: The Art Show is held on the Melbourne Cup Weekend in November. The process is as follows:

- + Thursday, 9 am the boards arrive, erect Boards, Art is delivered.
- + Friday 9 am Art work hung, Judge arrives and winners determined
- Friday 7 pm Official Opening, all Club members and partners invited.
- + Saturday 10 am Open to the Public, it will be part of the Art Trail this year. Raffle tickets sold for a donated painting.
- + Sunday 10 am Open to the Public.
- + Sunday 4 pm Closes. Art Works both sold and unsold collected.

Each of these tasks involves a roster of workers - Board Team (erect/ dismantle), Hanging, Catering, Raffle, Floor Walkers, Entry/Catalogue, Collection. We will need members to volunteer for all these teams, please help if you can. The Market is on the Sunday of this weekend so it will be very busy. There will be no meeting the following Tuesday. A social event will be held on the following Friday.
