Register them for sale at our 'Pre-Loved Art Sale'

It's in the Ocean Grove Pavilion, on the same weekend as our April market - sure to have a big crowd. Put a 'good' price on them and perhaps they'll move on :)

- Register the items for sale, pay a sale fee, drop them off on the Saturday before the sale.
- If they sell, you get 75% of the sale price. If not, they can be collected after the event. A good price will more likely result in a sale!
- Rotary members will supervise the venue, display the works and handle sales.

Conditions of entry

1. Each piece must clearly show the full name of the owner and the selling price.
2. Submitted pieces must be less than 5 metres in perimeter. (i.e. the total length of all sides added together) [no 3D work will be accepted]
3. Entry Fees: a non-refundable fee is payable with your submission (\$10); maximum of 4 (four) works per person.
4. A 25% commission on all sales will be deducted by the Rotary Club of Ocean Grove, and the Club will pay the balance of the price by E.F.T. to the art-work owner by 20th April.
5. The owner accepts and understands that the Rotary Club of Ocean Grove bears no responsibility for any loss or damage to owner's property whether before, during or after the sale; however the Rotary Club of Ocean Grove will take all reasonable care to reduce any risk, loss or damage to any property or exhibits.
6. Entries will be received for display between 1pm and 4:30 pm on Saturday 2nd April.
7. Owners may collect their unsold works at the conclusion of the sale. (4:30 pm Sunday 3rd April)
8. The Rotary Club of Ocean Grove:
 - will not in any way be responsible for cost of delivery to, or collection from, the exhibition venue.
 - cannot accept responsibility for uncollected works.
 - reserves the right to cancel the event due to unforeseen circumstances. In this case, entry fees would be refunded.
