Andy McKoy: The Ocean Grove Community Association is campaigning to support the current DAL recommendations to protect town boundaries in all towns on the Bellarine. The Andrews' Government promised the townships would be protected but developers have appealed. The next rally is on the 14th August at 10.30 at Edwards Point, St. Leonards. Rod Bush: Rotary Art Show - History and Process

Our Art Show began in 2001 initiated by Peter Dowling. It moved to the Point Lonsdale Primary School hall in 2012 with



Coral Barker taking over and placed an increased emphasis on the quality of the works submitted. In 2015, John Calnin introduced some new initiatives including increasing the prize pool. Rod Bush is now leading this project.

Funds raised support Riding Develops Abilities, the Disabled Surfers Association and a number of local charities. The number of entries has varied over the years and consequently the number of works sold and funds raised has also fluctuated. To date, we have sold approximately \$160,000 paintings and generated about \$40,000 in income for the Club.

The Art Show is held on the Melbourne Cup long weekend in early November. Members help is needed to stage the show starting on the Thursday when the Art works are hung and judged. Friday night is the opening event when prize winners are announced and is catered by Club members. It is open to the public on Saturday and Sunday. On Sunday around 4 pm people arrive to collect works they have bought and artists collect those which did not sell.

There is no Rotary meeting on the Tuesday. The November market is held around the same time, making it a busy period for everyone.
