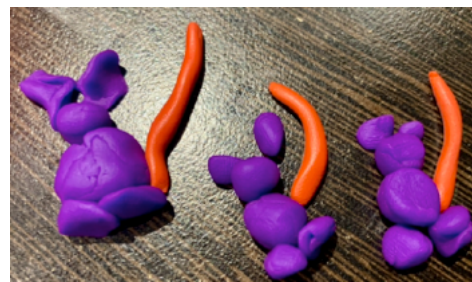

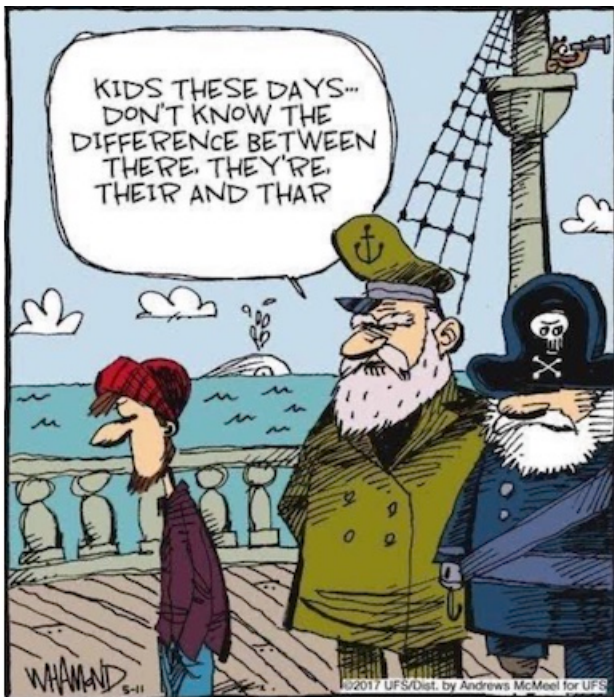
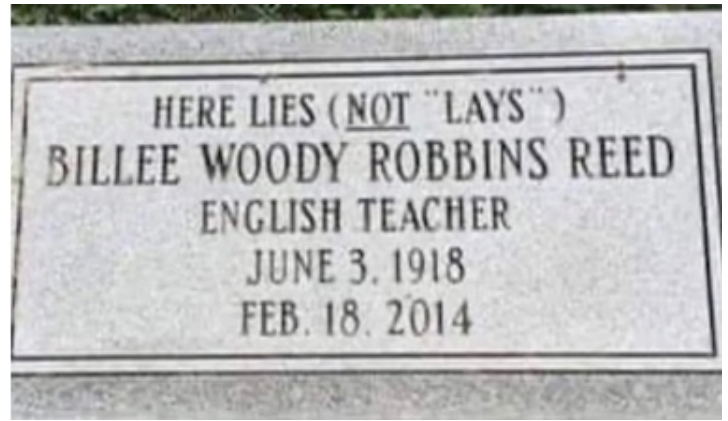


At our meeting last night, members awoke their inner artist as they celebrated 'National Play-Doh Day' producing some amazing pieces of play-doh
