

Guest Speaker: Jan Johannson, Bali Smiles

Jan also works at Feed Me Bellarine. She recently visited Bali. Jan is sponsoring 27 children who are presently at school in vears 8 to 12. They are apparently doing well, working hard. some with difficult circumstances. The schools are in various small villages. Transport appears very basic,



often restricted to motorbikes. Families are very thankful for the support received. Their living conditions are basic, most parents work so their children can attend school. Most of the students hope to work in the hospitality industry.

In their villages there are no Government services, no roads, no rubbish collection and a regular supply of electricity is not readily available. Most students have to study by torchlight. Those children who complete year 12, can be given three years work in animal husbandry and gain an income which will provide good support for the future. Most jobs in Bali require completion of year 12.

Ocean Grove Rotary is sponsoring six children. It costs \$600 to support secondary students and \$300 for primary students.


