
**Lynne Carlson, Vocational Committee**, said that the first Vocational Visit for this year would be on the 17th September. It involved a visit to the new Surf Club at 6 pm, followed by dinner at Driftwood at 7 pm. Partners welcome.

**Margaret Campbell, International Committee** reported that Noel Howard, District Chair of RAWCS had advised that there were several vacant positions on the committee. They were calling for nominees for three year terms. If you are interested, please nominate, the message has been sent to all members.

**Geoff Chandler, Footy Tipping** - Judy Greer won this week. Judy, Marion and himself all had seven winners this week with Judy winning on closest margin. Geoff Chandler and Graeme Chamberlain are now joint winners with Geoff Ford one behind. Alex is back next week.

**Guest Speaker: Jody Keating-Gorton, Ryman Health Care**  
Ryman have a Retirement Village - Aged Care Facility development proposed for Ocean Grove. It will be on the corner of Banks and Shell Roads. Ryman is a New Zealand company established in 1984. One of its' founders, Kevin Hickman, was looking for aged care options and did not approve of any the existing facilities.

He and his accountant, John Ryman, decided to start a trial facility. They offer independent, life-style villas and assisted low, high and dementia care in small apartments. Ryman now has 32 villages in New Zealand and two in Australia, with eight new villages proposed in



Melbourne plus the Ocean Grove facility. The Ocean Grove village has currently not been named. They are looking for a well known person who is relevant to the area. The facility will be designed and built by Ryman. It will offer in house prepared meals, and activities and events which will involve all residents. Residents also form clubs in areas of interest.

Ryman's philosophy is to be part of their community and partner with local organisations. They already sponsor a number of Ocean Grove clubs. They offer the Ryman Prize of \$250,000 each year to an innovator who has helped older people, for example with new technologies. It also supports a charity each year, in areas such as dementia or stroke, and all villages have fund raising activities for these causes. Construction will begin in early 2020. It will be built in stages starting with the independent living villas followed by the amenities block, assisted living areas and the care facilities. Pets are welcome.

The price of the villas has not yet been set but will be approximately 70% of the medium house price in the area. The price is repaid within six months with no extra costs other than a 20% deferred payment management fee, once residents leave. Residents are charged a fixed weekly fee of \$150 for services, which is not changed during each persons residency and stops immediately once you leave. There is a 90 day money back guarantee if you move in and are not satisfied.
